RE: P1061 -Code Maintenance Proposal 2023

Tēnā koe FSANZ,

GE Free NZ notes that the Code Maintenance Proposal P1061 to Standard 2.1.1 section 2.1.1-5 is to be amendment to state-

*"...to reflect the New Zealand Government's decision to require the mandatory addition of folic acid **to all** [Our bold] wheat flour that is sold as suitable for bread-making in New Zealand, in accordance with Standard 2.1.1 of the Code, on or from 13 August 2023".*

This updated wording in the Code Maintenance Proposal P1061 is inaccurate and does not reflect the NZ Government decision on July 8 2021 that specifies that only non- organic flour is required to be fortified with folic acid. This is the statement on the MPI webpage¹.

"... mandate fortification of non-organic flour used for bread making with folic acid by 2023".

The press release² on the decision by Dr Ayesha Verrall on 8 July2021 specified that

"Organic and non-wheat flour will be exempt from fortification, providing a choice for consumers who don't want to consume folic acid,"

We believe that the wording of "all" wheat flour this is a drafting mistake. We would like the directive to accurately reflect the decision passed down by the New Zealand government and amend the wording to –

*the New Zealand Government's decision to require the mandatory addition of folic acid **to non-organic** wheat flour that is sold as suitable for bread-making in New Zealand, in accordance with Standard 2.1.1 of the Code, on or from 13 August 2023.*

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
